Introduction

This brochure has been produced to support organisations to access training with regards to safeguarding children and supporting families in Bolton.

Important

- 3. Training may take place via online, Microsoft Teams, Zoom or face-to-face. See individual course details.
- 4. Generally, courses are restricted to 2 persons / organisation unless informed otherwise via email communications or similar

The courses are described as:

- Basic Awareness
- Intermediate
- Advanced

This is to guide delegates and managers in their course selection.

Basic Awareness – This is aimed at staff who don't routinely deliver direct work to children at risk or are new to their role. Staff will gain a generic and fundamental understanding of the topic area. E.g. knowledge on the risk, signs, and know how to seek advice and support.

Intermediate – This is aimed at staff working regularly with children and/or the risk is recognised in their work or role. As such they require a more in-depth knowledge of the subject area. The courses tend to cover definitions, effects, impact and trauma, risk assessment, interventions, and referral pathways.

Advanced – this is aimed at staff in a specialist role or where the subject is a consistent feature of their work and staff want to further develop their knowledge/expertise to be able to work with and advise others. E.g. Designated Safeguarding Leads
